Krankenpflegepersonal, Mediziner und klinische Forscher haben die Bedeutung von PsycINFO für Forschung in einem breiten Spektrum von Themen rund um die Krankenpflege erkannt, von Verhaltensaspekten bei der Krankenpflege bis zur Gesundheitsförderung, Krankheitsvorsorge und Patientenschulung.
